DP	The notation "[DP]" in a rule in the SI means that a breach of that rule denotes a rule may, at the discretion of the race committee, be a standard penalty without a hearing or, a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing.
NP	The notation '[NP]' (No Protest) in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

The event is governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the current “Racing Rules of Sailing” (RRS).
- 1.2 The ITA Class Rules and “Appendix C – International Events” and the “Equipment Inspection Regulations” will apply.
- 1.3 A boat chartered or loaned for the event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of the class rules (see RRS Appendix G.3).
- 1.4 In case of translation of any document, if there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing Instruction will be available upon confirmation of registration and from the 12th of July:

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board will be at the Racing Rule Of Sailing: <https://www.racingrulesofsailing.org/events/8010> and will be exposed at Club Nautico Rimini headquarters as well.
- 3.2 [DP] [NP] Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to the INTERNATIONAL TORNADO CLASS boats.
- 4.2 Documents required for registration:
 - 4.2.1 Italian competitors shall be member of the Italian National authority with a valid medical certificate and a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,5million € or the FIV PLUS Option;
 - 4.2.2 Non Italian Competitors shall be in compliance with their own National Authority and must be covered by a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,5million €;
 - 4.2.3 Minors: shall be allowed by the Parents or tutor to participate in sailing competition, downloading and signing the Parental Authorization at Attachment C of this NOR. The form must be sent by email to cnrimini@cnrimini.com;
 - 4.2.4 All the competitors may be in compliance with the ITA membership;
 - 4.2.5 Eligible boats shall have valid Measurement Certificates that comply Class Rules;
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter compiling the form published on the regatta’s pages:

4.4 Support persons and coaches vessels may enter compiling the form at Attachment D of this NOR

4.5 All the registrations will be completed paying the registration fee by Bank Transfer in € other currencies will be not accepted.

4.6 The documents that should be loaded in the registration portal are the following:

- Measurement Certificates that comply Class Rules;
- Support person rubber boat entry form, if any;
- Minor competitors only: Parental Authorization;
- Foreign competitors only: Membership cards of their National Authority and third party liability insurance policy with coverage of at least 1.500.000,00 € .

4.7 To be considered entered to the Event, a boat must be fully paid, eligible and fully compliant with the requested documents.

5. ENTRY FEES

5.1 Entry fee per boat:

- Early entries from the date of this NOR until April 30 th: 450,00 € per boat;
- Late entries from May 1st: 550,00 € per boat.

The Entry fees includes the following benefits:

- cars and boats park
- 1 gadget for competitor
- Access to the opening and closing ceremonies (for all)
- Official dinner for crews (family members and friends at 30,00 €/each)
- After daily races 1 drink and finger food for crews only (family members and friends at 5,00€/each)

7.4 Total Number of races: 10 races are scheduled for the regatta

7.5 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

8. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1 Equipment Inspection shall be conducted in accordance with the Tornado Equipment Inspection Regulations.

8.2 Each boat shall present a valid measurement certificate at Equipment Inspection

8.3 All boats must be kept at the regatta site commencing at the time of registration and continuing until the end of the event. Removal of any boat from the regatta site during the event shall require prior written permission from the equipment inspector.

8.4 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the Class Rules, Equipment Inspection Regulations and Sailing Instructions. On the water a boat may be instructed by the equipment inspector to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

9. REPLACEMENTS OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT

9.1 Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior written approval of The Race Committee, and only the case of sickness, accident, or special circumstances.

9.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorized by the Technical Committee, and that the equipment inspector deems to be damaged beyond repair. Requests for substitutions shall be made to the Technical Committee at the first reasonable opportunity. Replaced equipment must measure within the Class Rules.

10.2 The Boat Storage will be located at the venue of CNR, NOR attachment A.

10.3 Early arrivals. Early arrivals are not allowed in CNR and will be managed in Punto Vela Bellariva (Early Venue below).

11. RACING AREAS

11.1 NOR Attachment B "Areas" shows the racing areas of the Regatta, between Rimini Canal Port.

12. COURSES

12.1 The Championship Course as shown in the class rules Appendix C will be used (see Sailing Instructions for details)

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 The 2 turn penalty is changed to 1 turn penalty. This modifies RRS 44.1.

13.2 Decision of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5

14. SCORING

14.1 Four races are required to be completed to validate the regatta.

14.2 When 4 races or less have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

14.3 When 5 races or more have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15. SUPPORT PERSONS VESSELS

15.1 All support persons vessels shall be required to comply with local legislation and event support vessels regulations. The organizing authority may refuse registration and accept later registration at their sole discretion. NOR attachment D.

15.2 All support boats shall clearly always display the 3 letters of the national code of their WS Member national Authority while afloat and display the flag which will be delivered, upon completion of registration, by the regatta secretariat (deposit €10.00) .

15.3 Support persons vessels with team leaders, coaches and other support person shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished, or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall, or abandonment.

15.4 In the event of an emergency the Race Committee may request support vessels for their assistance (RRS Race signals, Flag V).

16. PRIZES

16.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

- Tornado Open: to the first 5 classified boats;
- Tornado Mixed: to the first 3 classified boats;
- Tornado Youth (each crew member under 26 years old at December 31st 2024) : to the first classified boat.

17. RISK STATEMENT

17.1 RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". The participants are aware that the sailing activity falls within those governed by article 2050 of the Italian Civil Code therefore all Italian participants must have a valid FIV membership, included medical validation, that guarantees accident coverage, including death and permanent disability.

Non Italian competitors must comply with the requirements of their MNA, if any, and be in possession of accident coverage, including death and permanent disability.

Italian competitors must comply with the requirements of Italian MNA, and be in possession of accident coverage, including death and permanent disability as per current FIV regulations.

18. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

18.1 It is recalled the Basic Principle which states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing", it is recommended that care be taken to protect the environment at all times during and after the event. Especially attention is drawn to RRS 47 -TRASH DISPOSAL- which states: "Competitors and support persons shall not intentionally put trash in the water. This rule applies at all times while afloat. The penalty for a breach of this rule may be less than disqualification".

19. DATA PROTECTION

19.1 Right to image and appearance: By participating in this competition, each competitor and his legal representatives authorize the OA, and its partners to use their image and name free of charge, to show at any time (during and after the competition) moving or static photos, films or television recordings, and other reproductions of itself taken during the competition, and this in any medium and for any use related to the promotion of their activities.

19.2 Use of participants' personal data. By participating in this competition, the competitor and his legal representatives' consent and authorize CNR and its sponsors to use and store their personal data free of charge. These data may be published by the CNR. and its sponsor CNR in particular, but also its sponsors may use this data for software development or for marketing purposes. In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations (RGPD), any competitor who has communicated personal data to the CNR may

Information & utilities and early arrivals



Rimini is a city in the Emilia-Romagna region of Northern Italy, with 152.000 people. Sprawling along the Adriatic Sea, Rimini is situated at a strategically important north-south passage along the coast at the southern tip of the Po Valley. It is one of the most notable seaside resorts in Europe, with 15 kilometers (9.3 miles) the coast, is a significant domestic and international tourist economy. The first bathing establishment opened in 1843. The city is also the birthplace of the film director Federico Fellini. The ancient Romans founded the Colonia of Ariminum in 268 BC, constructing the Arch of Augustus and the Ponte di Tiberio at the start of strategic roads that ended in Rimini. During the Renaissance, the city benefited from the court of the House of Malatesta, hosting artists like Leonardo da Vinci and producing the Tempio Malatestiano. Much of the city was destroyed during World War II. Following Rimini's liberation, reconstruction work began, culminating in huge development of the tourist industry in the city. The city center has a Roman structure, partly modified by following medieval transformations end, which has been reconstructed and restored in order to valorize its historic places and buildings.

Clime

Rimini has a humid subtropical climate moderated by the influence of the Adriatic Sea, featuring autumn and winter mean temperatures .

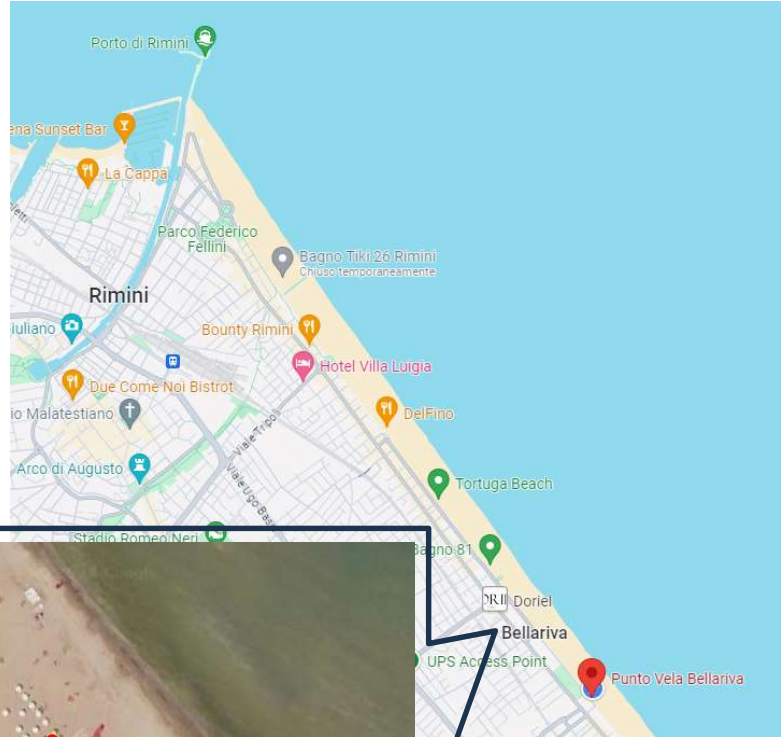
